

Summerbrooke Pool Rules 2023

We are excited to have you for our 2023 Pool Season. Our pool memberships run from the date of purchase- December 31, 2023. (Unless you have a club membership). Please remember all guests must be registered and paid for through our staff. It is also important for you to be informed of our pool rules. We also have our pool rules posted on our website. Please do not destroy any of our property, including our bathrooms. If you or your child breaks any of the pool rules, your membership will be terminated with no refund. Please note, we will periodically change the code for the keypad on the pool gate. When we do that, we will send an email or text to our pool members.

Please initial the lines below stating that you agree to our pool rules for 2023.

- 1. This is a Members Only Pool. Therefore, members must sign in guests with a server and settle guest charges at time of sign in. If you give the gate code to a non-member, your pool membership will be revoked, and you will not receive a refund of any kind.
- 2. No pets allowed in the pool or on the pool deck except for service animals.
- 3. No Diving, No Running, No Outside Food or Drinks, No Coolers, No Glass.
- 4. No Smoking in the fenced in pool area. (Please exit the pool gate to smoke)
- 5. No water guns, squirt guns, noodle guns of any type.
- 6. No oversize floats are allowed in the pool (pizza slices, lounge floats, large unicorns, etc) Flotation devices such as floaties, or life vests are allowed in the pool for recreational enjoyment but should not be used as water safety devices.
- 7. No throwing of balls in the pool or in the pool area (footballs, nerf balls,) Nothing with wheels is allowed in the pool area. (No skateboards, bikes, skates, etc).
- 8. Please apply sunscreen 30 minutes prior to entering the water to allow it to soak into your skin. Please shower off before entering the pool. With excessive sunscreen and body oils, it makes it extremely difficult to keep the water clear during the high populated times. Please do your part to help us with this issue.
- 9. Children should not be left unattended in the bathrooms and should not destroy bathroom property.
- 10. Children under 12 must always be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- 11. All diaper wearing children must wear a "swim diaper" to enter the pool. This is strictly enforced! If your child has an accident in the pool which causes the pool to temporarily close, there will be a chemical fee of \$250 automatically billed to your membership.
- 12. Do not drink the pool water.
- 13. If you have a cold, cough, fever, or infection of any kind you are not permitted in the pool.
- 14. No lifeguard is on duty, swim at your own risk, however, please note our pool hours.
- 15. We reserve the right to close the pool for special functions, inclement weather, or maintenance and repairs at the sole discretion of ownership/management. Please check your email, or social media for updates.
- 16. The restaurant and pool snack bar are now run by an independent company. They run on their own computer sales system so payment should be paid each time you order food and drinks. Charging to a monthly account will no longer be available.
- 17. If you choose not to close out your food and beverage tab, we will close it out and add 20% gratuity.
